## What's New in Node.js v0.12: Cluster Round-Robin Load Balancing

In the days of yore, an oft-lamented limitation of Node.js was its intrinsically single-threaded model. No matter how many cores your machine had, Node.js would utilize only one. That is why Node.js v0.8 saw the addition of the new built-in 'cluster' module. The cluster module lets you set up a master process that acts as a supervisor and one or more worker processes that perform the actual work.

The Android SDK provides simple API calls that enable your Android app to access Enterprise Data Stores and Services using REST API generated by Loopback, StrongLoop's mobile API tier. It enables you to interact with your models and data sources in a comfortable, first-class, native manner instead of using the clunky AsyncHttpClient, JSONObject, and similar interfaces.
